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AI AND AUTOMATION: TRANSFORMING FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

Artificial Intelligence (AI) and automation are rapidly redefining how governments manage public finances and deliver services. 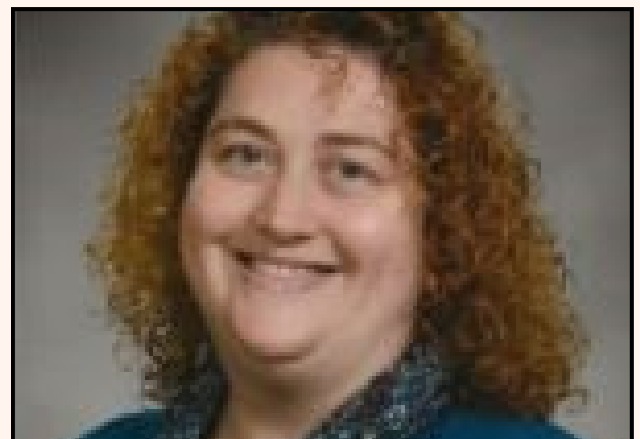
